- ◆ Practice reading scripture out loud to yourself...you may comprehend it in a whole new way.

### Speak It

- ◆ Speak Scripture passages of blessing over your family and friends.
- ◆ Speak Scripture into people's lives to offer correction and redirection.
- ◆ Memorize scripture so you have a "database" of Scripture to speak into individual's lives.

### Live It

- ◆ James 1:22 emphasizes being a DOER of the Word. How are you living that out?
- ◆ Ask others to hold you accountable and gently encourage you to put into practice what you learn.
- ◆ Find ways to work with others to live out the truth and principles that are found in Scripture.

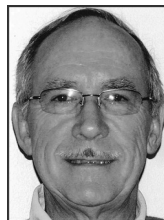

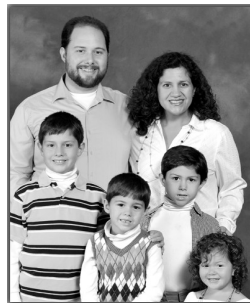
